

Drawing/Shading Workshop by Jeannette Rowe

This drawing workshop is designed to help children (9 years and up) to draw and develop their own drawing skills using shading and line with grey lead pencil and charcoal, to make objects and animals look more 3 dimensional. The workshop consists of a talk, a drawing demonstration and a practical workshop session, that takes about an hour to complete.

Children will have the opportunity to engage and practice drawing techniques that are designed to give confidence and enjoyment, while improving their own drawing style.

Workshop material requirements per child...

- . Charcoal stick
- . A3 Cartridge drawing/ sketch paper x six sheets
- . 4B and 6B greylead pencils
- . white rubber

Speaker requirements...

White board & Blue tack

Large A2 Cartridge drawing paper x one dozen sheets

Cartooning Workshop by Jeannette Rowe

The cartooning workshop uses a method especially created to assist children create their own cartoon characters and cartoon strips. Jeannette will talk about her work, demonstrate and conduct a practical cartoon workshop, lasting approximately an hour.

Children will have the opportunity to draw and create a number of their own new characters, in a way that is achievable for every student. This workshop is great for building confidence and expanding skill in competent drawers, while providing easy access back into to drawing for those who may have lost some of their drawing confidence.

Workshop requirements per child...

- . A fine felt pen or black biro
- . A4 photocopy paper (at least 6 sheets each)

Speaker requirements...

- . White-board or pin-board for 4 large sheets of cartridge paper
- . A3 photocopy paper and a thick black felt pen
